Event Management

For events held at the Village Hall , booking is usually not open until 5th of the month. For Outings, Lunch Club and Theatre trips you can book straight away.

NB: many events are initially oversubscribed so we maintain waiting lists. Whilst we are not able to guarantee a place, it is likely that nearer the date we would be able to offer one as we regularly get cancellations due to ill health / change of circumstances. Refunds are not guaranteed, however we endeavour to take individual circumstances into account.

Outings & Trips in 2026

Due to the popularity of the venue, we're planning two trips to Evesham this year (1st April and again in November). We have successfully applied for a 50% discount pass with the National Trust, and are planning visits to its Children's Country House in Sudbury and Charterhouse in Coventry. For July we have booked a private tour & afternoon tea at Guys Cliffe Walled Garden in Warwick.

Other trips being considered include a visit to Ragley Hall at Alcester, the Lord Leycester Hospital in Warwick, and a trip to Leicester for the Richard III Museum, city centre and shopping.

Management Committee

Following two resignations since the AGM for personal reasons, there are now only four trustees on the Management Committee, Ann, Colin, Jane & Liz.

All are jointly responsible for the efficient administration & finances of the charity, ensuring compliance with statutory and regulatory requirements. They also take the lead on organising the events and activities.

To help us run the Association, and ensure we continue to maintain the number of events offered, we are looking for additional support.

ENVELOPE for cash or cheque payments

When making payment by cash or cheque, for events such as Outings, Lunch Club or Theatre, as well as Acorn500, please ensure it is given to us in an envelope clearly marked with your name, event title and amount enclosed. An appropriate booking form (or the payment slip for Acorn500) should also be included.

It is difficult to manage cash security when money is handed over without this key information, and there is no paper trail for the Treasurer to refer to later.

With the closure of local bank branches, as well as the time it takes to count cash and process cheques, we'd like to encourage members to pay us by bank transfer for these events and Acorn500 where possible. We will of course continue to accept cash and cheques, however bank transfers help to reduce the time it takes to manage money received as well as providing a detailed record of payments.

Message from St Mary's

Many of you will have noticed that whilst we have been able to move the temporary barriers slightly, unfortunately they are still in place around the tower at St Mary's Church. Therefore, I thought it would be helpful to provide an update on what is happening. The drone inspection identified that the two finials on the North side of the tower are fine. On the South side, the finial that is still in situ has a hairline crack that requires repair, and in order to replace the finial that fell we firstly need to replace the central rod that originally held the stonework in place, before a newly carved stone finial can then be put in place. It is hoped that this work can be carried out using a 'Cherry Picker' rather than scaffolding.

As a Grade I Listed Building the work needs to be carried out by an authorised Professional. Having successfully received Diocesan Advisory Board permission, we are now waiting for a date when the stonemason can carry out the work required. It appears that whilst the insurance company will pay for the initial repair work already carried out on the roof, sadly it will not pay for the future work required including the replacement finial, so we will need to look to pay for that ourselves. We are hoping that the work will be carried out fairly soon, but sadly until then we cannot look to start ringing the bells again or to permanently remove the barriers.






